ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH

With excellent support from **Kaleesuwari Foundation** the first camp was conducted in Madurai on 1 Dec 2024. This was a Walk India distribution program well attended by their Senior management Ms Lakshmi Priya General manager Kaleesuwari, Mr. Venkatesan Regional Sales manager Kaleesuwari and also Mr. Gnanam Aram Porul Foundation and Mr. Murugan our local partner. From our side we had Mr. Sankaran Trustee representing Freedom Trust. We distributed **138** appliances to **115** beneficiaries.













The venue Bala mandir at T Nagar Chennai hosted a beautiful and emotional event on the **World disability day** being **3 Dec 2024**. The event had a few parents and children displaying their talent and also highlighting the challenges they had gone through to raise such differently abled children. The event was a Walk India Distribution sponsored by **Rotary Club of Mambalam**. The event also had some distinguished guests from Rotary and IMA like Rtn. N S Saravanan District Governor of Rotary District 3234, Dr Sunder Founder & Managing Trustee Freedom Trust, Dr Saravanan V IMA Hony secretary. From our side we had Mr. Sudarshan - Board Member and Mr. P S Prasad - Soft Member were present. We distributed 8 appliances to 7 beneficiaries.





Another Walk India assessment was conducted in Puttur on **7 Dec 2024**. **Thirumalai Chemicals** had been the sponsor for the event with City Hospital Puttur being the local partner. Members present for the distribution camp were RTN.Harshakumar Rai AG, Dr Sri Prakash and Mr. Jagan from Freedom Trust. We assessed for **56** appliances to **51** beneficiaries.





After the Lodge Ramprasad in camp Pondicherry we are seeing lots of interest from other Lodge members. One such interest has been from Lodge Accountants No.194 were in we have split their funds into two camps, one in Chitoor and other in Chennai. This assessment camp at Chitoor was on 13 Dec 2024 ably supported by the local body District Differently Abled Welfare Office, Chittoor. This assessment has resulted in identifying 38 beneficiaries and 43 limbs and appliances.



The other **Lodge Accountants No.194** distribution was in Chennai at their historic and iconic Lodge building off Commander in Chief Road Chennai. The program held on **21st Dec 2024** was conducted by them with their Regional Grand Master of Southern India Mr R W Bro Thotala Narayanaswamy Manoharan as their Chief Guest. The Lodge members acknowledged the outstanding work being done by our trust. Freedom Trust was represented by Dr Sunder Founder & Managing Trustee (Also a Lodge member), Mr. Sudarshan, Board Member and Mr. P S Prasad, Soft Member. We distributed **14** appliances to **12** beneficiaries.





Nice foggy morning Dr Sunder, Mr. Sudarshan and Mr. Prasad from Freedom trust drove down to Zwilling Foundation campus at Edayanchavady Auroville Pondicherry. The assessment campunder the sponsorship of **Fuji Electric** was conducted at the Zwilling Foundation campus on **28th Dec 2024**. This campus had a nice vibe and with so many programs being done for the poor and needy. We were also fortunate to meet Ms Bindhu Modi, Trustee of Zwilling Foundation India. The camp though was a GVP assessment, we ended up with many needing calipers and limbs. The camp was so moving with so many disabled children, young girls and highly motivated men who were self-employed (running cab services, food and essential delivery etc.) Mr. Prabhakar from Fuji Electric was present for the entire event ensuring all logistics and support system was given for this program. We distributed **106** appliances to **78** beneficiaries.
