

Toyota's Welwalk WW-100 -Robotic leg brace

Toyota has developed a robotic leg brace called the Welwalk WW-1000, designed to help individuals with partial paralysis regain the ability to walk. The device is a motorized, mechanical frame that fits on the leg from the knee down. It's intended for use by patients who have suffered paralysis on one or both sides of their body due to stroke or other conditions.

The gadget is designed to be worn on one leg at a time for patients severely paralysed on one side of the body due to a stroke or other ailments





Here's more detail about the Welwalk WW-1000:

• Target Users:

The device is designed for patients with partial paralysis, particularly those recovering from strokes.

• Functionality:

It provides motorized assistance to help bend and straighten the knee during walking, aiding the user in practicing and relearning gait patterns.

• Development:

The Welwalk WW-1000 was developed in collaboration with Fujita Health University Hospital.

• Rental Model:

Initially, Toyota will rent out 100 of these systems to medical facilities in Japan. The rental model includes a one-time initial charge and a monthly fee.

• Customization:

The device's assistance levels can be adjusted to suit the needs and progress of the individual patient, as determined by their therapist.

• Benefits:

The Welwalk WW-1000 can potentially reduce recovery time and improve the quality of life for individuals with partial paralysis.

Given how common paralysis due to strokes is in fast-aging Japan, Toyota's device could be very helpful, Saito said. He said patients using it can recover more quickly as the sensitive robotic sensor in WelWalk fine-tunes the level of support better than a human therapist can.
